The YFS offices are located at Kingston Road, Slacks Creek, Logan. YFS staff undertake outreach work across Logan. Logan City has a population of 306,000 and is located between Brisbane and the Gold Coast. YFS has 130 staff (full time, part time and casual).

- workplace induction including:

- formal supervision meetings (either fortnightly or monthly)
- feedback to field supervisor/student and formal comments in the learning plan
- all work will be supervised (there is no unsupervised client work for the student and the client has the right to decide if the student can be involved and can change their mind at any time)
- use of YFS infrastructure (including computer and work space).

University/TAFE responsibilities:

- development of the learning plan
- monitoring of the learning plan
- a decision in regards to the results of the placement.

Student responsibilities:

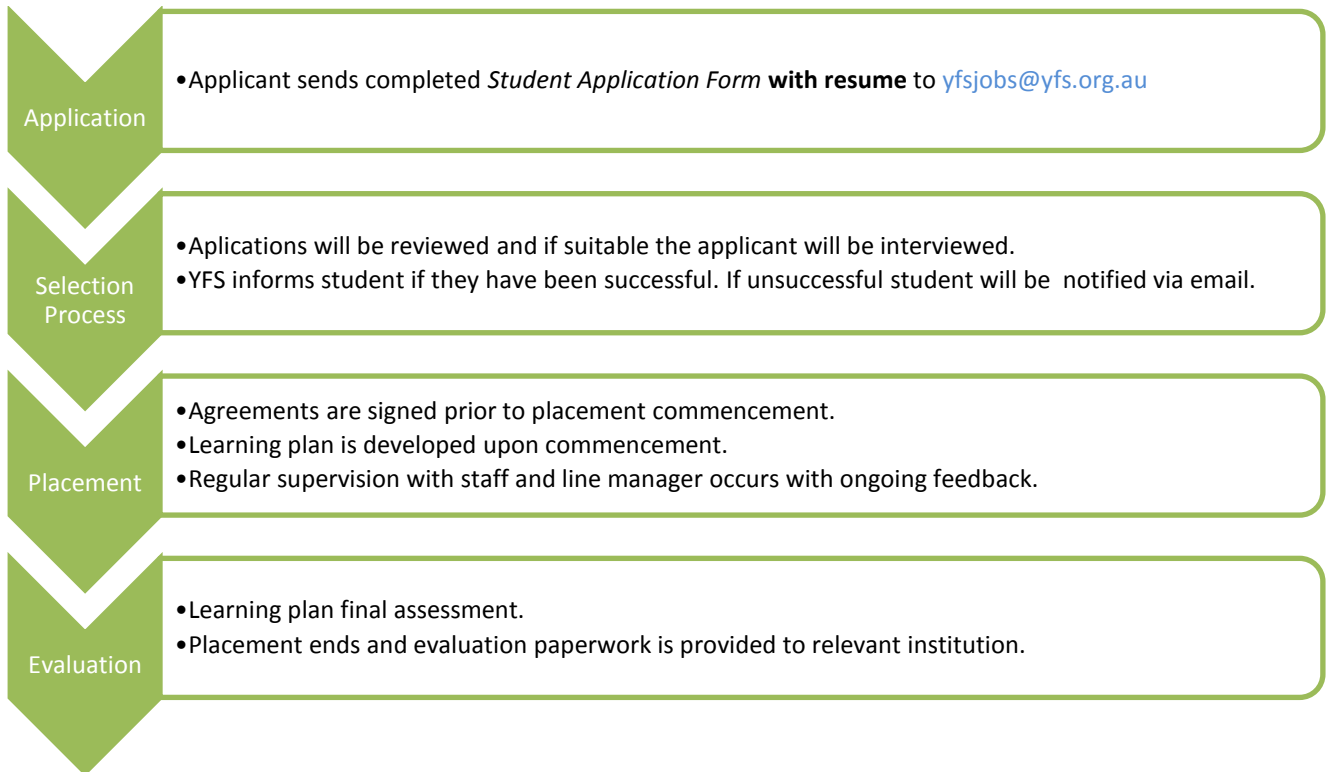
- always declare their student status and wear their YFS ID card
- not undertake course assignments at YFS while on placement
- have basic IT skills
- agreement to abide by YFS code of conduct, governance structures, policies and procedures
- agreement to YFS ownership of intellectual property and the right to use any materials derived from the placement
- be aware that YFS does not guarantee that all aspects of the placement can be completed at YFS and decisions on the final course assessment are the responsibility of the tertiary institution.
